

## **McLean County Peacemakers club meeting, February 15, 2014**

President Jack Vick called the meeting to order at 12:35pm. The treasurer reports \$2947.80 in the account and all bills are paid.

A slate of officers for 2014-15 was presented and approved by acclimation. Officers are:

A long distance shoot was proposed by President Vick to be held separate from regular club matches at Darnall's Range. A Quigley shoot of 100 yards offhand and 200 yards from cross-sticks; and a pistol-caliber shoot of 50 yards offhand and 100 yards from cross-sticks; 25 rounds per competitor. Ron Darnall volunteered to set it up this year, schedule to be decided later.

The annual Stage Trail Shootout was then discussed. Changing the schedule was deemed to be unworkable, so it will be held as the September club shoot on the third Saturday. Volunteers to run the event will be sought. Appaloosa Doc offered to loan his prop horse for the shoot.

President Vick plans for the club to purchase some more pistol targets, probably in high quality AR500 steel. We will also build a few more cow and horse props and repair the current ones. Broken target stands will be repaired (welded) by a member or by a contractor. An inventory of all club props, stands, and targets will be done this year.

The club has traditionally supported the Friends of NRA (FNRA) dinner through underwriting an item. We will continue to do so.

There was no new business.

Meeting was adjourned at 1:15pm.
